




Cleansing of the Sanctuary: Mistaken as Second coming of Christ October 22, 1844—the "Great Disappointment"

Design Protocols

Common SDA View of the Antitypical Day of Atonement (Cleansing of the Sanctuary)

- Christ entered the Most Holy Place in a building in heaven.
- He began cleansing the sanctuary from the sins of people.
- The Investigative Judgment began.
- All cases of professed followers are reviewed.
- God judges each case, keeping some and rejecting others based on whether sins have been retained in the books.
- Opening the books and doing this before the heavenly beings vindicates God's judgment.
- It culminates in the Second Coming.

WHAT IS REALLY HAPPENING IN THE SANCTUARY IN HEAVEN?

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What Is the Heavenly Sanctuary?

"Tell him this is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Here is the man whose name is the Branch, and he will branch out from his place and build the temple of the LORD. It is he who will build the temple of the LORD, and he will be clothed with majesty and will sit and rule on his throne. And he will be a priest on his throne. And there will be harmony between the two.' ... Those who are far away will come and help to build the temple of the LORD, and you will know that the LORD Almighty has sent me to you. As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him—you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:4, 5

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Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord.

The point of what we are saying is this: We do have such a high priest, who sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, and who serves in the sanctuary, the true tabernacle set up by the Lord, not by man. Hebrews 8:1, 2

Every worker is himself to become just what God designs he should be in building his own life with pure, noble, upright deeds, that at the end he may be a symmetrical structure, a fair temple, honored by God and man. God must be in this work. 'Ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.' Through you He has worked, and will work to do honor to His name by trusting to you these great responsibilities. ...

"... The Lord would have you stand forth as Daniel, every phase of your character under His own ministration, that day by day you may grow into a structure that will stand forth, not as a perfect whole in itself, but connected with the work of other chosen workmen, as a beautiful temple for the Lord, a living witness to the value, stability, and nobility of the man who keeps his eye single to the glory of God."

"The first tabernacle, built according to God's directions, was indeed blessed of Him. The people thus were preparing themselves to worship in the temple not made with hands—a temple in the heavens. The stones of the Temple built by Solomon were all prepared at the quarry and then brought to the Temple site. They came together without the sound of ax or hammer. The timbers were also fitted in the forest. The furniture was likewise brought to this house all prepared for use.

"Even so, the mighty cleaver of truth has taken out a people from the quarry of the world and is fitting this people, who profess to be the children of God, for a place in His heavenly temple. We want the cleaver of truth to do its work for us ...

"We are taken from the quarry of the world. The material must not be a dead substance but living souls, and these souls must be brought out of the quarry of the world, where the hand of God can fit them for the temple in heaven. We are here as probationers, and we must pass under the hand of God. All rough edges and rough surfaces must be removed and we must be stones fitted for the building. We are brought into church capacity with defects of character, but we must not retain them. We must be fitted and squared for the building. ...

"... We must be "laborers together with God," for we are "God's husbandry," we are "God's building." In view of this we must see that our temple is not defiled with sin. We should be lively stones, not dead ones, but live ones that will reflect the image of Christ. We must be worshipers in spirit and in truth." 3 Manuscript Release, p. 231

FROM WHAT IS THE HEAVENLY SANCTUARY BUILT? DEAD MATTER OR LIVING BEINGS?

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When he [Satan] lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies. John 8:44 NIV84

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From the opening of the great controversy it has been Satan's purpose to misrepresent God's character and to excite rebellion against His law, and this work appears to be crowned with success. Patriarchs and Prophets, p. 338

God was represented as severe, exacting, revengeful, and arbitrary. He was pictured as one who could take pleasure in the sufferings of his creatures. The very attributes that belonged to the character of Satan, the evil one represented as belonging to the character of God. Signs of the Times, January 20, 1890

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Eve believed the words of Satan, and the belief of that falsehood in regard to God's character, changed the condition and character of both herself and husband. They were changed from good and obedient children into transgressors. *Review and Herald*, January 5, 1886, par. 8

- Lies believed = broken love and trust.
- Broken love and trust = fear and selfishness (survival of the fittest).
- Fear and selfishness = destructive acts (sins).
- Destructive acts (sins) damage the mind, character, and body = a terminal condition.

"The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God." Galatians 5:19–21 NIV84

"In the cleansing of the temple, Jesus was announcing His mission as the Messiah, and entering upon His work. That temple, erected for the abode of the divine Presence, was designed to be an object lesson for Israel and for the world. From eternal ages it was God's purpose that every created being, from the bright and holy seraph to man, should be a temple for the indwelling of the Creator. Because of sin, humanity ceased to be a temple for God. Darkened and defiled by evil, the heart of man no longer revealed the glory of the Divine One. But by the incarnation of the Son of God, the purpose of Heaven is fulfilled. God dwells in humanity, and through saving grace the heart of man becomes again His temple. ...

"... God designed that the temple at Jerusalem should be a continual witness to the high destiny open to every soul. In cleansing the temple from the world's buyers and sellers, Jesus announced His mission to cleanse the heart from the defilement of sin,—from the earthly desires, the selfish lusts, the evil habits, that corrupt the soul. ...

"... 'The Lord, whom ye seek, shall **suddenly come to His temple**, even the Messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, He shall come, saith the Lord of hosts. ... But who may abide the day of His coming? and who shall stand when He appeareth? for He is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap: and He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and **He shall purify the sons of Levi,** and purge them as gold and silver.' Malachi 3:1–3." *Desire of Ages*, p. 161

Object Lesson

"The gifts and sacrifices being offered were **not able to clear the conscience of the worshiper.** They are only a matter of food and drink
and various ceremonial washings—external regulations applying until the
time of the new order. ... But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of
sins, **because it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.**" Hebrews 9:9, 10; 10:3, 4

- Passover: As soon as humanity fell into sin, God passed over their sins.
 "He left the sins committed before hand unpunished." Romans 3:25
- Christ is the lamb of God slain from the foundation of the world. Revelation 13:8
- Time covered by the Passover: From Adam's sin until Jesus' victory at the cross.

- Unleavened Bread: Immediately, God began dispensing truth unmixed with error to nurture and save, but it was internalized by those in sin, which is represented by the bitter herbs.
- This represents the time from Adam's fall until Christ's victory.
- Eating the unleavened bread symbolizes the internalization of Jesus.

- Feast of First Fruits: The first fruits of the victory over death.
- The Wave Sheaf: Represents Jesus, the ultimate first fruit, who was buried and rose again in sinless perfection.
- Those who arose with Him on resurrection morning to everlasting life.

- Feast of Weeks (Pentecost): The pouring out of the Holy Spirit to apply what Christ achieved and bring forth a harvest of healed souls.
- This occurred after Christ's death on the cross as the benefits
 of His achievement were dispensed into trusting human hearts.
- Symbolically spans the time from Pentecost (AD 31) until the Loud Cry.

- Trumpets: A special message for the end time.
- The Loud Cry: Awake, prepare, get ready—it is time to be reconciled and brought back into unity, at-one-ment, with God again!
- Late 18th and Early 19th Century: The Great Awakening in Christianity and the Millerites.

- Atonement: Reunification with God; oneness with Him
- The healing and restoration of Christlike character within;
 a settling into the truth from which one cannot be moved.
- From the mid-19th century until the second coming of Christ.

 Tabernacles: After we have been restored to at-one-ment in heart, mind, and character, Christ returns and we tabernacle with Him again in the earth made new—our new Eden garden home for eternity!

WHAT ARE THE "RECORDS" IN HEAVEN? PARCHMENTS? BOOKS? DATA RECORDINGS?

What Is Recorded in the Heavenly Books?

But you have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven.

Hebrews 12:22, 23 NIV84

Nothing impure will ever enter it [New Jerusalem], nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

What Is Recorded in the Heavenly Books?

At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered. Daniel 12:1

IN SCRIPTURE, WHAT DOES A "NAME" SYMBOLIZE?

CHARACTER

The founder of the SDA Church wrote:

What do the books of heaven say in your case? Are you conforming your character to the Pattern, Jesus Christ? Are you washing your robes of character and making them white in the blood of the Lamb?" What Is the Cleansing of the Sanctuary?

The final removal of all the defects from the characters of the people who have trusted Jesus. It is the sealing, the settling, both intellectually and spiritually, of the saints into eternal loyalty to God so that nothing will shake them from it—the wedding, uniting, bonding of hearts to Jesus make us a pure people at-one with Him!

What Is the Judgment?

There are four judgments in Scripture.
The first two apply to the cleansing of the sanctuary. The last two come after and won't be discussed in this presentation.

First Judgment

- Satan lied about God.
- Jesus reveals the truth about God.
- We must judge: Is God like Satan says or is God like Jesus revealed?
- This judgment of ours determines whether we choose to trust God and open our hearts or not.

"Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come,' says the Lord Almighty. But who can endure the day of his coming? Who can stand when he appears? For he will be like a refiner's fire or a launderer's soap. He will sit as a refiner and purifier of silver; he will purify the Levites and refine them like gold and silver. Then the Lord will have men who will bring offerings in righteousness, and the offerings of Judah and Jerusalem will be acceptable to the Lord, as in days gone by, as in former years. 'So I will come near to you for judgment." Malachi 3:1–5

- This is the Judgment of the Great Physician, diagnosing what is wrong and determining the best therapeutic intervention.
 - God bringing "judgments" upon rebellious people throughout history to alert, to convict, to redeem, to protect, to redirect, and to keep open the avenue for Messiah (Flood, Sodom, captivity).
- Jesus' work in the heavenly sanctuary to identify (judge):
 - Who has trusted Him and given Him access to their hearts.
 - What residual elements of sin remain to be removed in order to perfect them for the resurrection and Second Coming.

He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God." 2 Thessalonians 2:3, 4

The Spirit Temple!

How did Satan "set himself up" in God's temple?

- By changing how we view God's law—from design to imposed. Daniel 7:25
- And by presenting God as a dictator, cosmic executioner, the source of punishment and death.
- Thus, the world goes into an age of darkness.
- And God's ability to cleanse His people is obstructed.
